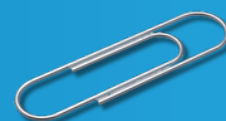

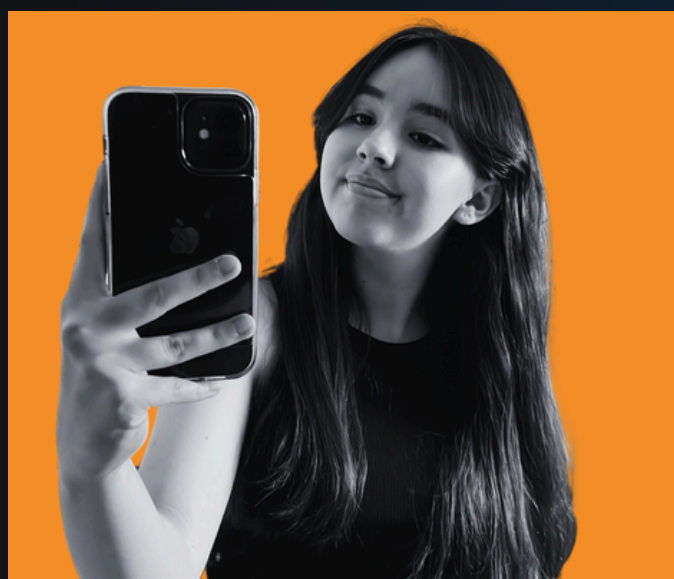


What the students are saying...
